Presenters I will, with God's help.

Celebrant Do you renounce Satan and all the spiritual forces of wickedness that rebel against God?

Presenters I renounce them.

Celebrant Do you renounce the evil powers of this world which corrupt and destroy the creatures of God?

Presenters I do.

Celebrant Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Savior?

Presenters I do.

Celebrant Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?

Presenters I do.

Celebrant Do you promise to follow and obey him as your Lord?

Presenters I do.

The People stand, and the celebrant addresses the congregation, saying

Will you who witness these vows do all in your power to support Chloe in her life in Christ?

People **We will.**

Celebrant Let us join with Chloe and those who are committing themselves to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

The Celebrant says

Grant, O Lord, that all who are baptized into the death of Jesus Christ your Son may live in the power of his resurrection and look for him to come again in glory; who lives and reigns now and for ever. **Amen.**

THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

Celebrant The Lord be with you.

People **And also with you.**

Celebrant Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

Celebrant We thank you, Almighty God, for the gift of water. Over it the Holy Spirit moved in the beginning of creation. Through it you led the children of Israel out of their bondage in Egypt into the land of promise. In it your Son Jesus received the baptism of John and was anointed by the Holy Spirit as the Messiah, the Christ, to lead us, through his death and resurrection, from the bondage of sin into everlasting life. We thank you, Father, for the water of Baptism. In it we are buried with Christ in his death. By it we share in his resurrection. Through it we are reborn by the Holy Spirit. Therefore in joyful obedience to your Son, we bring into his fellowship those who come to him in faith, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Now sanctify this water, we pray you, by the power of your Holy Spirit, that those here are cleansed from sin and born again and may continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Savior. To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be all honor and glory, now and forever. **Amen.**

THE BAPTISM

The candidate is presented by name to the Celebrant, who then pours water upon, the candidate, saying:

Chloe, I baptize you in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

People loudly **Amen.**

Celebrant Let us pray.

Heavenly Father, we thank you that by water and the Holy Spirit you have bestowed upon this your servant, the forgiveness of sin, and have raised her to the new life of

grace. Sustain her, O Lord, in your Holy Spirit. Give her an inquiring and discerning heart, the courage to will and to persevere, a spirit to know and to love you, and the gift of joy and wonder in all your works. **Amen.**

Then the Priest places a hand on the person's head, marking on the forehead the sign of the cross and saying
Chloe, you are sealed by the Holy Spirit in Baptism and marked as Christ's own for ever.

People loudly **Amen.**

Celebrant Let us welcome the newly baptized.

Celebrant and People

We receive you into the household of God. Confess the faith of Christ crucified, proclaim his resurrection, and share with us in his eternal priesthood.



**We were pleased to welcome as a visitor this past week
Bishop H. William Michael Tajra.**



Bishop H. William Michael Tajra (pronounced TOY-RA) is the Founder of the Marial Museum of Sacred Art, the outreach work of the Lutheran monastic society, The Order of St. Mary the Virgin. He holds a Masters degree in sacred theology from the Protestant Theological Seminary in Paris, a doctorate from the University of Paris (Sorbonne) and an advanced degree from the University of Geneva in Switzerland. He is an historian and a scholar in the area of sacred art.

The Bishop has published two scholarly works on early Church history and is currently writing a book on a painting by the 17th Century French-Flemish artist, Philippe de Champaigne, entitled, The Vow of Louis XIII: Icon of France.

Bishop Tajra has lectured internationally at universities, seminaries and academies in both Europe and the United States and is a member of the National Institute of Slavonic Studies (University of Paris) and a corresponding, non Roman Catholic, member of the Pontifical International Academy (Vatican City), an honor bestowed in recognition of his work in promoting unity, dialogue, and reconciliation.



We want to thank **ALL** of our volunteers that keep All Saints going! This week we want to recognize Phyllis Barnes for her dedicated service to the T.R.U.E. Fund.

Did you ever wonder what happens with the money that you put in the envelope marked **TRUE FUND** or the check you made out marked **TRUE** (Toward Relief of Urgent Emergencies)? In all instances, checks from TRUE are made out directly to the vendor such as FPL or to a supplier for medications rather than the client and the grant is \$100.00 or less. Requests come from a variety of social agencies and are always thoroughly vetted before being granted.
