
A READING FROM THE BOOK OF ACTS OF THE APOSTLES 5:27-32.

THE GOSPEL OF OUR LORD ACCORDING TO JOHN

Deacon The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to John 20: 19-31

People **Glory to you, Lord Christ.**

When it was evening on the day of Resurrection, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

But Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."

A week later his disciples were again in the house, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were shut, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas answered

him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have come to believe." Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book. But these are written so that you may come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

People **praise God. Hallelujah!**

Intercessor Healing One, you have absorbed all human suffering and pain into your body through Jesus and raised him with power to become our wounded healer: Grant the comfort of your grace to those for whom we pray, especially ____ (*add special intentions*). You have loved us and freed us, O God: Hear our grateful thanks for all the blessings of our lives, especially for those celebrating birthdays and anniversaries this week and ____ (*add special intentions*). You have overcome death through the victory of Christ: Grant your resurrection life to those whom we remember, especially for Paul Miller, father of Jeff Miller, and ____ (*add special intentions*). Let everything that has breath,

People **praise God. Hallelujah!**

People **Almighty God, giver of every good gift: Look graciously on your church, and so guide the minds and hearts of those who shall choose a rector for All Saints that we may receive a faithful pastor and priest who will join us in ministry in our parish, town and diocese through Jesus Christ Our Lord. Amen.**

Celebrant Honor our doubts, O God, and let the Risen One visit us with divine healing presence in our lives and fill us with your joy, that we may be grateful witnesses of Christ's resurrection, breathing the liberating breath of your Holy Spirit extending forgiveness and peace throughout creation, for to you is glory and dominion for ever and ever. **Amen.**

Holy and gracious Father: In your infinite love you made us for yourself; and, when we had fallen into sin and become subject to evil and death, you, in your mercy, sent Jesus Christ, your only and eternal Son, to share our human nature, to live and die as one of us, to reconcile us to you, the God and Father of all. He stretched out his arms upon the cross, and offered himself in obedience to your will, a perfect sacrifice for the whole world.

On the night he was handed over to suffering and death, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread; and when he had given thanks to you, he broke it, and gave it to his disciples, and said, "Take, eat: This is my Body, which is given for you. Do this for the remembrance of me."

After supper he took the cup of wine; and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, and said, "Drink this, all of you: This is my Blood of the new Covenant, which is shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Whenever you drink it, do this for the remembrance of me."

We celebrate the memorial of our redemption, O Father, in this sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving. Recalling his death, resurrection, and ascension, we offer you these gifts.

Sanctify them by your Holy Spirit to be for your people the Body and Blood of your Son, the holy food and drink of new and unending life in him. Sanctify us also that we may faithfully receive this holy Sacrament, and serve you in unity, constancy, and peace; and at the last day bring us with all your saints into the joy of your eternal kingdom.

All this we ask through your Son Jesus Christ. By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit all honor and glory is yours, Almighty Father, now and for ever. **Amen.**



ECW Pill Bottle Ministry



PLEASE NOTICE THE BASKET OF EMPTY PILL BOTTLES, AS WELL AS OVER-THE-COUNTER BOTTLES IN THE NARTHEX

Ever wonder what to do with all those empty pill bottles? ECW has adopted a program, sponsored by M25M (Matthew 25 Ministries), of recycling those bottles. Clean bottles with the labels removed are sent to places around the world where they are needed to dispense medicines that would otherwise be wrapped in clothing, paper or other means that would cause the medicines to lose their potency.

ECW has learned the M25M is a disaster and international humanitarian organization that collects and distributes the bottles. They have an enormous warehouse located in Blue Ash, Ohio. To find out more about them visit their website at www.matthew25ministries.org. It is important to know that 99% of their donations go to programs and are used where and when needed!
