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On 4/5/2020 at approximately 0227 hours, I responded to 333 Tarpon Drive(All Saints Episcopal Church) to assist FLFR with an arson investigation. Fire rescue advised they observed a male with dark clothing holding a large suitcase and a white pillow fleeing the area. A perimeter was set, K-9 responded.

Fire rescue advised that the arsonist entered the church through the south side church door. The suspect vandalized the church before setting the church on fire. Det. Arenas responded to the scene. Sgt. Guerra was notified and responded to the scene.

While canvassing the area, several cameras were discovered around the church. Officer Elizee responded and assisted with processing the scene for latent prints. Several photographs was captured and uploaded to evidence.com. A box of matches was recovered from the scene and submitted into evidence.

On 4/5/2020 at approximately 0208hrs, I responded to 333 Tarpon Dr in reference to a commercial structure fire. The dispatched call advised of FLFR seeing a W/M with a suitcase walking away from the building which was on fire. Prior to my arrival a perimeter was established and apprehension K9 was summoned. Upon arrival, I took a perimeter point at Brickell Dr and Tarpon Terrace. I later readjusted after a possible culprit siting to SE 10th Ter and SE 2nd Ct. Bradley Wright was ultimately detained and I responded to 1021 East Las Olas where the culprit was located.

Upon arrival and contact with the Wright, Wright made multiple derogatory statements and was stating he needed to go to the hospital. Wright then asked if he could stand to which he was told multiple times no. At one point I advised Wright he would be "Slammed" if he stood. I then again told him he would be seated back down if he attempted to stand. Wright then advised if I touched him he would kick my knee inside out. Wright continuously made multiple threats to me throughout our contact. (See BWC) Once Wright`s warrants were confirmed he was walked over to Ofc. Lamparelli`s vehicle (V6601). While walking to the vehicle Wright attempted to kick me in the knee. Wright then made the following statement to me, "I`m gonna come back and I`m gonna get you and I`m gonna watch the light drain out of your eyes, up close and personal." A search incident to arrest of Wright then took place.

Throughout the search Wright failed to comply with officers orders and I used my arm to push him against the vehicle to keep him from pulling away from the vehicle. While doing this Wright stated he was going to "fuck him up" also directed towards me.

I then attempted to inventory/search Wright`s property. Wright then began kicking the rear driver`s side window to the prisoner compartment of Ofc. Lamparelli`s vehicle. At this point multiple officers attempted to place Wright into a hobble strap. Due to Wright`s unruly and resistant behavior, I pulled Wright flat on his back in the back seat by his shoulder and held him down by his head until the hobble strap was properly applied.


I then continued the search of Wright`s belongings. During the search I located numerous food items, which were discarded into a trash can due to the food being unable to be received into FLPD evidence for prisoner property (oreos, coffee, chocolate sticks, cookies/crackers, 1 bottle of ZEP glass cleaner). 

On 04/05/2020, I responded to the area of 333 TARPON DR in reference to a commercial building fire; see the report for further. While on my perimeter point, I observed a white male matching the description of the BOLO for the possible subject of the fire to the rear of the buildings in the 1000 block of E LAS OLAS BLVD. Upon observing him, I advised this information via department-issued radios and the subject was detained by K9 Officers at 1021 E LAS OLAS BLVD in reference to the investigation.


When asked, the subject identified himself as "Rahula Wrighte Himapulli". I asked the male several times if the name he was providing was his legal name or name on his ID CARD, however, he provided that this was the name given to him based on religious beliefs. A finger-print scan by Ofc. E. Ershowsky #1989 of the subject was conducted and revealed that the subject's name was Bradley Richard Wright. Let it be noted that prior to learning the subject's name, Bradley began to act combative and would not give officers his hand or fingers to be scanned. Officers on scene physically had to pry Bradley's hand open as he was resisting the lawful command to open his closed fist. Officers explained to Bradley that the device was being used to verify his identity and name. Bradley was subsequently charged for RESISTING WO VIOLENCE for providing a false name to Law Enforcement Officers while they were conducting their investigation. Additionally, Bradley was charged for refusing to give officers his hands while conducting their investigation while attempting to identify him.

Upon a FLPD TTY check, it was revealed that Bradley has two possible warrants out of Virginia- Full Extradition. The warrants were later confirmed by FLPD TTY and confirmed that Virginia would be extraditing. The warrants are in reference to case number 200404032170A; 1 count MONEY LAUNDERING and 1 count WALK AWAY FROM HALF HOUSE.

While waiting for FLPD TTY to confirm the warrants, Bradley became extremely combative towards officers, began yelling loudly and started to disobey commands. Bradley continued to disregard officers commands as he would continuously stand up while being advised to sit down. Officers on scene then assisted Bradley to the ground by holding his arms and pushing his chest in a downward motion. Bradley then stated that he would "begin to do yoga and take my firearm out of the holster and shoot himself and officers on scene". Bradley also stated to Officer Nabhan #1911 that he was going to "come back and get him (officer)." Additionally, Bradley stated to Officer Nabhan "I'm going to watch the light drain out of your eyes, up close and personal." See Officer Nabhan's report for further. Bradley also began kicking the windows of my patrol vehicle, slamming his head on the inside of my patrol vehicle and disobeying lawful commands to comply. It should be noted that as Bradley became more and more combative, he was restrained with hobble restraints. Bradley was subsequently charged 2 counts of 838.021-3B CRIMES AGAINST PERSON-CORRUPT BY THREAT PUBLIC SERVANT.

Additionally, FLPD TTY confirmed that Bradley was listed as a `missing person` out of Broward County Sheriff's Office. Bradley appeared to be in good health and was taken out of the system as a missing person by TTY Operator #8538 at approximately 0323 hours.

Bradley was TOT BSO MAIN JAIL where he continued to act in a combative manner.

WHEN I SPOKE WITH HAGUE ON 04/05/20, SHE ADVISED THEY DO NOT HAVE A BURGLAR ALARM SYSTEM, THEY DO NOT HAVE CAMERAS INSIDE THE CHURCH AND WHEN THEY CONTACTED THE FIRE ALARM COMPANY TO SEE WHO WAS ON THEIR CALL OUT LIST, THE PERSON LISTED IS NO LONGER WITH THE CHURCH.

WHEN I REVIEWED THE CCTV ON 04/05/20, I SAW THERE WERE PEOPLE SLEEPING AND WALKING AROUND IN THE JENSEN COURT AREA WHICH IS ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE CHURCH.

0047 HRS: W/M (WHITE LONG SLEEVE SHIRT WHICH WAS OPEN, LONG PANTS, WHITE TENNIS SHOES WITH BLACK STRIPE, BLUE BASE BALL CAP, BLACK BACK PACK WITH "NIKE" ON IT) WALKING AROUND.

0048 HRS: SECURITY LIGHTS TURN OFF

0054 HRS: W/M (LONG PANTS, LONG SLEEVE SHIRT, BASE BALL CAP ON BACKWARDS, BACK PACK AND MAN'S SACHEL TO THE RIGHT FRONT OF HIS BODY) WALKING AROUND AND HE WAS FOLLOWED BY A POSSIBLE B/M (BLK & WHITE HOODIE WITH THE HOOD UP OVER HIS HEAD, GLASSES, LONG PANTS.

0206 HRS: PEOPLE GOT UP, PACKED UP THEIR PROPERTY AND LEFT.

0208 HRS: A PERSON ON A SCOOTER AND THREE OTHER PEOPLE WALKING LEFT THE PROPERTY THROUGH THE FRONT GATE.

0216 HRS (POSSIBLY) A MALE EXITED THE CHURCH THROUGH THE FRONT DOOR.

0227 HRS: FIRE DEPT. MADE ENTRY THROUGH THE FRONT DOOR.

WHILE ON PATROL THIS MORNING, I SAW MILEUR STANDING BY HIS SCOOTER ACROSS FROM THE CHURCH.

MILEUR GAVE THE FOLLOWING ACCOUNT: HE WAS SLEEPING ON THE WESTSIDE OF THE CHURCH BY THE RESTROOMS. HE SAW A THIN WELL DRESSED W/M (6-00, THIN, BLONDE HAIR, LIGHT COLOR LONG KHAKIS, SHORT SLEEVE POLO SHIRT AND A MAN'S SACHEL WITH A ZIP ON THE TOP) WHOM HE HAD NEVER SEEN BEFORE, STANDING BY THE ENTRANCE TO ST. LUKE'S CHAPEL WHICH IS ON THE WESTSIDE OF THE CHURCH (OUT OF CAMERA VIEW). JOHN, THE ASIAN MALE, TOLD HIM HE SAW THIS MALE PRESSING THE BUTTONS ON THE DOOR LOCK BUT HE DID NOT HEAR THE BUTTONS BEEPING. THIS MALE OPENED THE DOOR. 

On April 23, 2020 at approximately 1830 hours I, Detective Arenas, was notified by Officer Haritos that he was in contact with potential witness Mr. Dang, AKA John. I arrived at their location at approximately 1900. While thereat, Mr. Dang refused to provide me with a sworn statement but agreed to cooperate with my investigation. He also refused to view an official line up for identification purposes. Mr. Dang informed me that on the day of fire, he was asleep on the side of church, by the tent. He advised that he was awoken by a white shirtless white male, with tattoos on both sides of his torso, and on his forearms. Mr. Dang advised that the subject asked him, and others sleeping outside, to go and sleep inside the church, which had been opened. Mr. Dang further advised that the only person who went inside the church, aside from the aforementioned white male, was a young black male. Mr. Dang advised that said black male left premises and area very shortly after entering. Mr. Dang also advised that the black male left prior to the fires being started. Mr. Dang stated that the only person who went inside the church, who was also making a lot of noise, which sounded as if he was moving things around or breaking things, was the white male described above. Mr. Dang states he does not remember the subject's face, but recalls seeing the aforementioned tattoos. Mr. Dang advised he would cooperate further should we have any more questions.

Video footage from the church's entrance shows a white male exiting the church minutes after everyone else had left due to the fire alarm being set off. Said male walked out the front door and the door closed behind him. He attempted to open the door again but found it to be locked. He proceeded to walk towards the west side of the church, by the tent, where he disappears from the camera-view. He was the last person seen leaving the premises before FLFR showed up and broke a window to gain entry. A BOLO was sent to FLPD officers. Officer Nebham positively identified said male as Bradley Wright; the person who was arrested by Officer Lamparelli the night of the arson a few blocks away from the incident.

Investigation is on-going.





On 04/05/2020, I responded to the area of 333 TARPON DR in reference to a commercial fire. While on my perimeter point, I observed a white male matching the description of the BOLO for the possible subject of the commercial fire to the rear of the buildings in the 1000 block of E LAS OLAS BLVD. Upon observing him, I advised this information via department-issued radios and the subject was detained by K9 Officers at 1021 E LAS OLAS BLVD in reference to the investigation. The subject was identified as Bradley Wright. I later arrested Wright in reference to outstanding warrant(s).

On 04/13/2020, I received a BOLO via department- email for an arson suspect in reference to this case from Det. Arenas. Upon viewing the BOLO, I identified the subject as Bradley Wright, a W/M subject that I arrested while on the above listed perimeter. I was able to identify Bradley Wright as the individual in this photo due to the unique attire that Wright was wearing. Wright was wearing white sneakers with three stripes, a long purple colored shirt, and a long scarf.

Additionally, Wright was carrying two bags on his person, a dark colored backpack and a satchel like shoulder bag. Both of the bags were cut off of Wright due to his combative state. Wright`s property including an orange Columbia suitcase (the rolling suitcase that was described in the initial BOLO) and a blue Nike backpack were placed into FLPD Evidence as Prisoner Property. Both the backpack and suitcase had micellaneous personal property; see supplement for further items inside of suitcase.

Lastly, the tattoos shown in the BOLO were consistent with the tattoos that I observed on Wright`s upper arms.

I then spoke with Det. Arenas and confirmed the identity of the above listed subject. At that time, I was instructed to complete this supplement.

No further action.

The content of this document is based on information obtained during the course of my investigation, my observations of the incident and a review of the recording captured by a body worn camera system.

SYNOPSIS:

This incident occurred at 333 Tarpon Drive, at approximately 0208 hours on April 5, 2020. The fire alarm system was activated during the fire, dispatching the fire department. Upon arrival I met with Captain Suarez who said that upon their arrival they saw a person with a suitcase running west away from the church. They also discovered multiple fires inside the church. He indicated that the fire alarm system was sounding. See his narrative for more information.

SCENE DESCRIPTION:

The involved structure was a church composed of CBS construction. The structure was located in a residential/commercial neighborhood and it faced west. The building was equipped with a commercial grade fire alarm system.

FIRE SCENE EXAMINATION:

No fire damage was noted to the exterior. The electrical service appeared to be intact, however, someone at one point shut off the three main electrical power disconnects, that were located on the east exterior wall of the building. I had the FLPD dust the three electrical disconnect handles for fingerprints. The doors to the involved structure were forced open by the FLFD during fire fighting operations. I noted three locations in the church that were intentionally set on fire. These locations included: a fire located in the main lobby, which consisted of a chair, paperwork and a Dell laptop, another fire located in the main sanctuary floor in front of the altar, which consisted of some articles of clothing, and a third fire at the Chapel altar, which consisted of the altar tablecloth being set on fire. At the time of my investigation I could not determine which one of the fires was set first. Several exterior digital cameras were noted affixed to the involved building. FLPD will be responsible for extracting videos from these cameras at a later time. No natural or accidental fire causes were noted. Digital photographs were taken of the scene by the FLPD. It appeared that the three fires were intentionally set by someone at some point. The fire loss was estimated at \$10,000.00.

LATENT INVESTIGATION:

There was no one present representing the Church to interview during my investigation. I spoke to Detective Alejandro Arenas, who was the detective present during my investigation. He said that they will be responsible for securing the Church at the conclusion of the investigations.

EVIDENCE:

Samples of charred debris were taken from all three locations to be sent out for processing.

CONCLUSION:

Based on the information and physical evidence available this fire was ruled incendiary. It appeared that the three fires noted were intentionally set.

STATUS:

The fire investigation was closed. The property was turned over to the FLPD.

I asked the male several times if this was his name, however, he provided that this was the name given to him based on religious beliefs. A finger-print scan by Ofc. E. Ershowsky #1989 of the subject was conducted and revealed that the subject's name was Bradley Richard Wright, see her supplement for further.

Upon a FLPD TTY check, it was revealed that Bradley has two possible warrants out of Virginia- Full Extradition. The warrants were later confirmed by FLPD TTY and confirmed that Virginia would be extraditing. The warrants are in reference to case number 200404032170A; 1 count MONEY LAUNDERING and 1 count WALK AWAY FROM HALF HOUSE.

While waiting for FLPD TTY to confirm the warrants, the defendant became extremely combative towards officers. Defendant stated that he would "begin to do yoga and take my firearm out of the holster and shoot officers on scene". Defendant also stated to Officer Nabhan #1911 that he was going to "come back and get him (officer)." Additionally, defendant stated to Officer Nabhan "I'm going to watch the light drain out of your eyes, up close and personal." Defendant also began kicking and disobeying lawful commands to comply.
