

TRAFFIC STOP LIGHT PACKETS

ARE AVAILABLE IN THE NARTHEX.

This is a great way to share with those in need who are on the streets asking for a handout. Instead of giving cash, you can give a “ packet” that will give them some nutriment to help them through the day. Plus, there is a note that is included in the packet that gives them the phone number to a “Broward Help Line” and also a comment that “God loves you.” The packets are a bargain for \$3 each or 2 for \$5. The funds that are collected are recycled into the “Outreach Fund” to purchase more supplies for the packets.
