So he summoned him and said to him, 'What is this that I hear about you? Give me an accounting of your management, because you cannot be my manager any longer.' Then the manager said to himself, 'What will I do, now that my master is taking the position away from me? I am not strong enough to dig, and I am ashamed to beg. I have decided what to do so that, when I am dismissed as manager, people may welcome me into their homes.' So, summoning his master's debtors one by one, he asked the first, 'How much do you owe my master?' He answered, 'A hundred jugs of olive oil.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, sit down quickly, and make it fifty.' Then he asked another, 'And how much do you owe?' He replied, 'A hundred containers of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill and make it eighty.' And his master commended the dishonest manager because he had acted shrewdly; for the children of this age are more shrewd in dealing with their own generation than are the children of light. And I tell you, make friends for yourselves by means of dishonest wealth so that when it is gone, they may welcome you into the eternal homes.

"Whoever is faithful in a very little is faithful also in much; and whoever is dishonest in a very little is dishonest also in much. If then you have not been faithful with the dishonest wealth, who will entrust to you the true riches? And if you have not been faithful with what belongs to another, who will give you what is your own? No slave can serve two masters; for a slave will either hate the one and love the other, or be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth."

Outdoor Movie Nights in Brion Park coming in October!

We have long desired to offering great events and ministries for our local community, especially families. Enter Ballyhoo Media, who approached us about starting an outdoor movie night in Brion Park. We are thrilled to partner with them for this exciting new ministry!

Have you seen the boats in the boat parade that have huge LED screens? Imagine watching a movie on one of those. Now you don't have to imagine – you can experience it right in Brion Park!

Once a month, Ballyhoo will dock their 72ft boat – with a SIXTY-foot-wide LED screen – on the New River and set up a sound system in Brion Park for all our guests. In addition to providing the boat, screen, and sound system, Ballyhoo takes care of purchasing the licensing necessary to screen movies for all to enjoy.

All Saints will sell tickets for the movies: \$5/person; \$10/household; kids 10 and under FREE! We will also have concessions for sale. There will be a popcorn machine, ice cream, face painting and games.

Audience members are asked to bring their own lawn chairs or blankets, just like the boat parade.

Our first movie will be Encanto on Saturday, October 22, at 7:00pm. This movie about an enchanted family living in an enchanted house is wonderful for kids and adults alike. The music written by Lin-Manuel Miranda (who wrote a little musical you might have heard of called "Hamilton) is catchy, so be forewarned you may go home singing it (ask anyone who has ever heard "We don't talk about Bruno")!

Dear friends of Laundry Love South Florida,

Laundry Love South Florida met this past Tuesday, September 13, 2022, from 4-7 p.m. at The Laundry Spot (The Laundromart), 1410 N Federal Highway, Hollywood, FL 33020. We helped wash and dry 122 loads or 2440 lbs. of clothing and bedding for our 23 guests! Special thanks to our volunteers, including Mother Leslie, Katie, Father Carl, Florence, Joe, Rick, Helen and Rich.

What was different this month? The number of families who came! Almost every one of our guests was washing a bunch of clothing or bedding for their families. In fact, we hit our highest ever number of loads washed per guest this month, at over 5 loads per guest vs our normal average of half that amount! Why is this number significant for families who are in need?

- Lack of accessible laundry equipment due to their living conditions and/or lack of money to buy detergent and/or pay for laundromat facilities causes poor and homeless families and individuals to have difficulty in cleaning their clothing and bedding.
- Sociologists and teachers tell us that homeless or low-income children often miss school and suffer socially and academically because they do not have clean clothes (body odor issues).

We don't know the exact number, but we can guesstimate that your support enabled over 50 children to go to school this week with clean clothes. So many of our guests stopped by to thank us this week, and one comment especially touched us: "God Bless you and everyone at All Saints for doing this. I would not have been able to wash my kid's clothes this month, it was either this or not feed my kids several meals."
