THE GOSPEL

Gospeler The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Matthew 22:1-14..

Once more Jesus spoke to the people in parables, saying: "The kingdom of heaven may be compared to a king who gave a wedding banquet for his son. He sent his slaves to call those who had been invited to the wedding banquet, but they would not come. Again he sent other slaves, saying, 'Tell those who have been invited: Look, I have prepared my dinner, my oxen and my fat calves have been slaughtered, and everything is ready; come to the wedding banquet.' But they made light of it and went away, one to his farm, another to his business, while the rest seized his slaves, mistreated them, and killed them. The king was enraged. He sent his troops, destroyed those murderers, and burned their city. Then he said to his slaves, 'The wedding is ready, but those invited were not worthy. Go therefore into the main streets, and invite everyone you find to the wedding banquet.' Those slaves went out into the streets and gathered all whom they found, both good and bad; so the wedding hall was filled with guests.

"But when the king came in to see the guests, he noticed a man there who was not wearing a wedding robe, and he said to him, 'Friend, how did you get in here without a wedding robe?' Our guests joined us at The Laundry Spot Hollywood, 1410 N Federal Highway, Hollywood, FL 33020, and enjoyed pizza, all kinds of baked treats, cold waters, and a loving atmosphere as we had our third busiest month ever! We helped clean clothing and bedding for our 50 guests as they washed 261 loads, over 5,000 lbs. of dirty laundry!

Here are some cool statistics of accomplishments from our first four years:

- *We have served 1524 guests.**
- *207 volunteers have helped.**
- *7482 wash loads were cleaned.**
- *Over 72 tons of clean clothing and bedding!**
